Dear Sir,

We sincerely thank you for your efforts and cooperation for introducing our web-based Facilitation System (FS) with your members (employers) and encouraging them to adopt it. Their active support has enabled us to bring record of their **36953** employees online. Such development shall facilitate payment of benefits to pensioners and their survivors in a hassle free manner. I want to acknowledge with profound regards that such progress on FS was not possible without your positive role, contribution and cooperation of our valued employers.

However, I would now like to invite your attention toward those employers who regrettably fail to timely pay due contribution or default completely after paying for a few months without any legal excuse. The reasons for this lapse may have been a few like (a) their own carelessness (b) negligence of their staff responsible for ensuring payment of contribution (c) accumulation of previous unpaid contribution and (d) financial crises (e) unawareness from benefits of EOB Scheme to their employees. It is a fact that pensions are paid out of the amount of contribution received from employers and default on contribution payment might affect such pension payment adversely in future. An outcome that no responsible person would welcome as EOBI caters for hundreds of thousand of pensioners, (whose numbers are increasing on daily basis). Further such default on contribution payment would render a blow to the entire exercise of bringing data of insured persons online when there would be no contribution payment against the employees whose data was brought online?
